

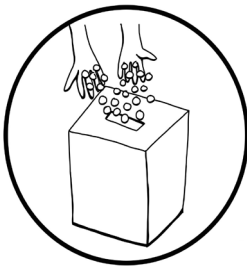
Face to Face Bible Bits
